UCMJ ARTICLE 91. INSUBORDINATE CONDUCT TOWARD WARRANT OFFICER, NONCOMMISSIONED OFFICER, OR PETTY OFFICER:

Any warrant officer or enlisted member who-

- (1) strikes or assaults a warrant officer, noncommissioned officer, or petty officer, while that officer is in the execution of his office;
 - (2) willfully disobeys the lawful order of a warrant officer, noncommissioned officer, or petty officer; or
 - (3) treats with contempt or is disrespectful in language or deportment toward a warrant officer, noncommissioned officer, or petty officer while that officer is in the execution of his office,
- shall be punished as a court-martial may direct.

PERSONNEL INSPECTION: Immediately after quarters Monday, 18 October a personnel inspection will be conducted of the Line Division by LTJG JONKERS. The inspecting Officer will be accompanied by the officer presenting the division and the Duty YN/PN.
